- 1. Poultry for Patriots is a Program designed to give back to our Military Service Members, Veterans, and their families (Patriots) through the donation of poultry or related items (i.e eggs and meat). For the purposes of this Program, we have defined a Patriot as a service member who is currently serving in the Military or a Veteran who possesses an Honorable or General Discharge from the Military. Other forms of military discharge will be considered on a case by case basis only. Verification of current Active Identification Card or DD 214 is required upon application.
- 2. Poultry for Patriots's goal is to meet each Patriots wants and needs by selecting a donation that suits their situation best. We will do the best to guide and educate you on the breeds and types of poultry available, but we are not responsible for the care and well being of the animal after placement.
- 3. All costs associated with donated poultry's care passes from the Contributor to the Patriot at the time of donation or after shipment to include care of animal, food requirements, housing and shelter, as well as medical costs if any.
- 4. Because our Program is the conduit between chicken farmer and Patriot, we cannot be held responsible for the health and condition of your livestock. Although some of the best breeders in the country have signed on to donate as well as many backyard farmers, problems with individual birds do arise. Our goal is to connect you with live, healthy birds, but we make no guarantees on breed or lineage of the animals.
- 5. Poultry for Patriots assumes the Patriot has checked with this local government to ensure there are no ordinances prohibiting poultry ownership prior to donation. Some areas do not allow roosters, and some restrict areas to no livestock at all. A quick call to you local town hall or other local institution is highly recommended.
- 6. We will try and honor specific breed requests where ever possible. When we locate a donor in your area we will let you know what is available. You may chose to accept that donation or decline at your own discretion. Declining an offer does not make you ineligible for a donation in the future, as we understand different factors for selecting the composition of your flock exist.
- 7. Returning an animal: Should find you are unable to care for the donated animals for any reason, please contact the donor or Poultry for Patriots with assistance in rehoming.
